

### Legislative Report

### Democrat dreams of complete healthcare control

Currently low-income illegal inhabitants under the age of 26 and over age 55 can apply for Medi-Cal. Governor Newsom proposes not only extending Medi-Cal to all illegals, but envisions an expanded program for all low-income residents titled California Advancing and Innovating Medi-Cal or CalAIM. This proposal aims to care for the "whole person" by requiring case managers to integrate health, behavioral, income-support, and housing services for enrollees. Released inmates would automatically be enrolled in CalAIM. He also hinted at increased use of "conservatorship" for the severely mentally ill, so they cannot refuse housing and treatment. These proposals, if enacted, may decrease homeless encampments. Unfortunately, the programs will be instituted using the neo-Marxist lens of Diversity, Inclusion, and Equity (D.I.E.), which discriminates against people whose skin tone is considered "white" and places no value on citizenship.

Our Democrat assemblymen dream of complete state control of healthcare. AB 1400 was passed by the Health Committee and Assembly Constitutional Amendment 11 introduced to pay for the single-payer plan. If eventually approved by 2/3 of the citizens of California, the amendment would roughly double state taxes.

Relinquishing more control to government health bureaucrats and financially-dependent healthcare institutions will endanger lives. These institutions have shown us in their response to coronavirus that what they value most is maintaining their regime position and funding sources. The Federal government helped fund the development of Sars-CoV2, suppressed early Covid 19 treatments, promoted ineffective (and potentially dangerous) hospital treatments such as Remdesivir, prioritized non-whites for monoclonal antibody treatments, ignored natural immunity, impaired child development with masks, and promoted the injection of leaky experimental "vaccines" into healthy children and young adults. Our government inflates Covid 19 death rates and ignores and suppresses reports of vaccine injuries, such as myocarditis, heart attacks, strokes, neurological disorders, immune suppression, and death. The U.S. Supreme Court has failed to protect healthcare workers, many of whom have natural immunity, from an unconstitutional vaccine mandate. I did see protestors on a pedestrian bridge in San Rafael with the banner "Democrats Against Mandates." Citizens of all political persuasions must unite in order to preserve or reestablish our freedom from medical assault.

ESA funds can be used to pay for tuition at any accredited public, private or parochial school. Any unspent funds will accrue in a low-risk portfolio. Parents would never have direct access to the money. However, homeschool students can also enroll in an ESA and use ESA funds to pay for qualified educational expenses if they enroll in an accredited private school independent study program. Because funds can accrue, families would be able to save the extra money in their accounts for students to use at an accredited college or vocational school up until the student turns 30.




