Local Political News

District 10 Assemblyman **Marc Levine** foregoes a sixth and final term in order to run for State Insurance Commissioner against incumbent Ricardo Lara, a gay person of color. If elected, Levine plans to force insurance companies to provide affordable fire and health care plans and hopes to combat climate change by regulating insurance company investments.

District 1 Marin County Supervisor **Damon Connolly** plans to continue his political career with a 2022 bid for the assembly seat. Connolly, a lawyer with roots in Marin County, promotes

renewable energy and was a founding board member of Marin Clean Energy. Of note, on 12/20/2018 while driving his Prius under the influence, he damaged a stop sign and left the scene. After his arrest, Connolly replaced the sign, performed community service, and gave up alcohol.

Assisted Suicide Waiting Period Now 48 Hours

One day after placing a moratorium on new hospice applications because of widespread fraud including misdiagnosis of patients as terminally ill, Governor Newsom signed SB 380 which decreases the waiting period from 15 days to 48 hours for the terminally ill wishing to commit suicide with physician assistance.

Governor Newsom Plans To Make Covid 19 Vaccination Mandatory For School Attendance

Newsom announced [on 10/1/2021] his intention to add the Covid 19 “vaccine” once approved by the FDA to the list of required vaccinations for in-person school attendance. A personal belief exemption has not yet been removed for the Covid 19 “vaccine.” Most children are at very low risk from Covid 19 because of strong natural immunity.

The Pfizer “vaccine” is designed to make the cells of your body produce the spike protein from the original strain, not current variants. Any antibodies produced will be against a strain no longer circulating. Mice studies showed concentration in the ovary, and if injected into a blood vessel, inflammation of the heart and liver. Once millions of our cells are infected with the “vaccine” our immune systems will try to destroy the infected cells. California under Governor Brown removed the personal and religious belief exemption for required vaccinations 7/1/2016. Preschool, daycare, and K-12 students currently must be vaccinated against polio, diphtheria, tetanus, whooping cough, measles, mumps, rubella, chicken pox, and hepatitis B.

Democrat Attacks on Truckers Impair Supply Chain, Cause Oil Spill, and Increase Air Pollution?

The Huntington Beach oil spill may have been caused by the anchor of a container ship waiting to be unloaded. California port backups contribute to air pollution. Why is this happening? AB 5 which affected the ability of trucking companies to contract with owner-operators, California air quality regulations on truck engines built before 2010, vaccine mandates, and retirement of truckers all contribute to decreased trucking capacity. Governor Newsom and President Biden have been unwilling to make emergency policy changes to solve the problem. Paying longshoreman overtime to work 24/7 is not the solution for a trucking problem.

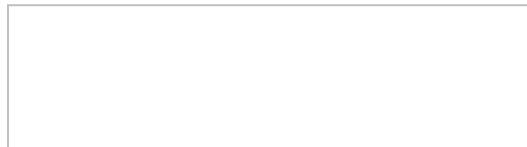
