**Speakers: Frank Drouillard and the Marin Election Integrity Committee  
Topic: Yes, Marin County Elections Are Being Stolen!**



The Marin Election Integrity Committee (MEIC) observes Marin County elections, evaluates voter rolls and election results, publishes reports on its findings and gives presentations to educate the public. The MEIC recruits, trains, and schedules election observers.

Our work has been shared by the Republican Club of San Francisco and Catherine Engelbrecht of *True-the-Vote* and her documentary "2000 Mules," as well as

former Congressman Louie Gohmert. Our chief data analyst, Ron Elijah of Novato, recently attended Mike Lindell's August 2023 "Moment of Truth Summit" on election fraud at the invitation of Dr. Douglas Frank.

Key findings from the Marin November 2022 election include the discovery that 7,947 in-person Republican-rich ballots were excluded from the certified vote and that the gap between Democrat vote totals (67%) and Democrat registrations (45%) can only be accounted for by a non-DEM plus non-REP (largely NPP) turnout higher than Democrat turnout with 100% of them voting for the Democrat candidate.

The MEIC is currently updating its training materials based on experience gained from observing the November 2022 general election. Observer recruiting and in-person training will ramp up in October 2023. Online Zoom classes will be available in January and February of 2024. ## President's Report

### Become a Vote Center Worker!

Please encourage all of your friends to complete this application to become a Vote Center worker.

This is the information from the Marin County Website:

[Election Worker Application - Elections - County of Marin \(marincounty.org\)](#) If you have questions: Call (415) 473-6439, the Elections Office.

The Marin County Elections Department is always looking for people committed to the democratic process who can serve at a vote center, especially those that can speak Chinese, Spanish, or Vietnamese. Election workers must be able to read and write English. Election workers use computers to look up voters and issue ballots. They also help the site coordinator to open and close the vote center. Training is provided before each election.

#### Responsibilities and expectations:

- Attend a mandatory training class.
- Set up and store laptops at vote center daily.
- Assist Vote Center Coordinator where needed, including monitoring the ballot box and voter waiting areas, and helping keep the vote center clean.
- Assist voters with check-in and ballot printing using laptop computers.
- Be available to work at a vote center for four days.
- Arrive 30 minutes prior to vote center opening and leave when directed by the Coordinator.
- Provide your own transportation to and from the vote center.
- Treat all voters with courtesy and helpfulness.

#### The current stipend rate is \$725 and includes:

- \$25 for mandatory training
- \$150 each day for Saturday, Sunday, and Monday
- \$250 for Tuesday, Election Day

Those who can commit to working all four days at a vote center will be placed first. If you cannot work all days, you can still apply. You may be placed the days you are available or called to replace a worker that drops out. Vote center workers must be able to read and write English.

### Anatomy of the Administrative State - Part 1\*

"Give me liberty or give me death!" declared Patrick Henry in 1775. He and his compatriots were fighting the oppression of the British Crown in the Revolutionary War. Today our oppression comes not from foreign lands but from our own state, which dominates our lives in every conceivable way.

American revolutionaries would not comprehend the extent to which the state now controls our lives. Its tentacles are everywhere. COVID is merely the leading case. Our technocratic overlords regulate fishing rods, dog food, cow flatulence, and the holes in Swiss cheese. They supervise our speech, employment, bank accounts, and media. They indoctrinate our children. They control the money supply, the interest rate, and the terms of credit. They track, direct, incentivize, censor, punish, redistribute, subsidize, tax, license, and inspect.

It wasn't supposed to be this way. Our constitutional architecture of three equal branches (legislative, executive/administrative, judiciary), each with distinct jobs was specifically designed for "the rule of law" to dominate. That is, legislatures pass rules, executive/administration executes and enforces those rules. The courts apply the rules to specific disputes. ### Legislative Report

Hundreds of bills were passed by the state legislature. October 14<sup>th</sup> is the deadline for Governor Newsom to sign, veto, or let the bills become law without his signature.

#### The Good

SB-14 Serious felonies: human trafficking sponsored by Republican State Senator Shannon Grove will make the sex trafficking of minors a serious crime and eligible for the Three Strikes Law. The Assembly Public Safety Committee voted against the bill over concerns that it would increase incarceration rates. The movie Sound of Freedom which focused attention on child sex slavery was released July 4th and several weeks later Governor Newsom, a possible presidential aspirant, used his political clout to rescue the bill.

SB-815 Healing arts (Roth) includes a quiet repeal of the 2022 law AB 2098 which subjected physicians who disagree with the official Covid narrative to disciplinary action. (The enforcement of AB 2098 was already blocked by Judge William B. Shubb pending the result of litigation.)

Governor Newsom has announced that California will spend \$267 million to help law enforcement crack down on large-scale organized retail store theft. Thieves are increasingly armed with guns and bear spray. (AB-331 passed in 2021 re-established a crime task force to deal with this increasing problem.)

#### The Bad

Democrats continue their attacks on the innocence of children in the name of tolerance with AB-1078 Instructional materials and curriculum: diversity (Jackson) which will force school boards to expose children to gender ideology, critical race theory, and pornographic materials. Of note, Jennifer Siebel Newsom, the governor's wife, writes and directs films promoting this agenda and licenses the films to public schools.

AB-665 Minors: consent to mental health services (Carrillo) allows vulnerable children 12 years of age and older to agree to mental health services without parental consent, substituting state indoctrinated and paid counsellors for the guidance of parents.

The Democrats continue to promote the hormonal and surgical disfigurement of susceptible children by passing AB-957 Family law: gender identity (Wilson) which instructs judges to consider the parent's affirmation of gender identity in custody cases and AB-223 Change of gender and sex identifier (Ward) which makes gender change court proceedings of minors confidential.

The neo-communists, one cut at a time, continue their progressive attack on middle class homeowners and suburban communities in the name of housing equity. SB-423 (Wiener) Land use: streamlined housing approvals: multifamily housing developments extends previous laws limiting local control to Coastal Zones. (A Coastal Zone is defined as land within several

hundred feet of the medium high tide in cities and within 5 miles of the high tide mark in rural areas.) The bill also allows the State to build housing on state owned land without considering local impacts. AB-309 (Lee) The Social Housing Act would create a new government agency, The California Housing Authority to regulate new housing policies, develop and manage new housing, and evaluate the progress toward socialist goals. Curiously, the Democrats were conveniently unable to find a solution to the crisis in the home insurance market created by bureaucratic regulations and delays in processing insurers' rate increase requests. Democrat policies destroy markets, create crises, increase government control in the name of solving the crises which further destroys markets, creates worse crises, et cetera.

#### The Ugly

Perhaps the most disastrous of all their policies is the plan to sacrifice middle class prosperity and freedom, sea mammals, and birds on the offshore wind turbine altars of their Climate Change god. AB-1373 Energy. (Garcia) gives the Department of Water Resources the authority to purchase offshore wind power. In 2018 the 100 Percent Clean Energy Act was passed which requires that all electricity supplied to customers and state agencies be renewable and zero carbon by 2045. Public power utilities have not been willing to fund the fledgling offshore wind power companies, so the state has stepped in and will fund offshore wind power projects through a surcharge on our electricity bills.

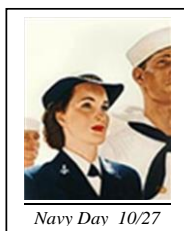

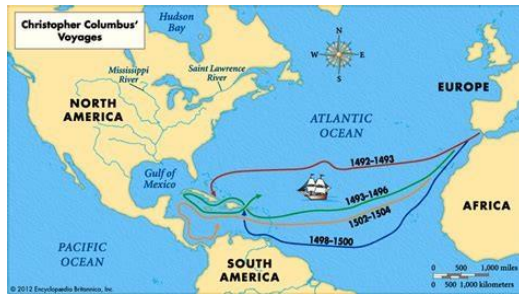
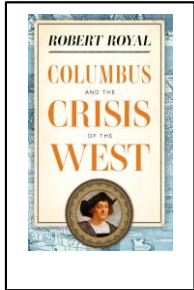
