### The First 45 Words – Our Freedom of Speech & the Press

"The words are plain, blunt and unequivocal — without literary frill or poetic flourish — a directive intended to put the natural rights of citizens above and beyond the punitive power of the new federal government: 'Congress shall make no law . . .'"

That opening phrase of the 45 words that would become the First Amendment to the U.S. Constitution was "a harsh admonition to officials of the new government. Hands off, the amendment says. Hands off religion! Hands off dissent! Let the people speak out. Let them publish critically about their elected officials and petition to right whatever wrongs they perceive done them."

And it usually was, but where are we in 2022? Earlier this year, our current administration proposed a "Disinformation Governance Board" within the Department of Homeland Security to combat "Russian cyber and election misinformation." Or rather to silence those who think the 2020 election may have been stolen – or at least had irregularities. Fortunately the "Disinformation Governance Board" has not (yet) become a reality. Americans of all stripes — right, left, and independent — who believe in those first 45 words need to ensure that this "governance board" never becomes a reality.

### Legislative Report

#### **In 2022 our legislators and governor tightened state control:**

**SB 1419** allows health care providers to deny parents access to the "sensitive" medical records of their minor children. Conversely, SB 1184 allows health care providers to disclose your child's medical information to a school-linked services coordinator.

**SB 1479** mandates the implementation of a state approved Covid 19 testing plan in every school and daycare center.

**AB 2098** threatens physicians who give medical advice contrary to the official Covid 19 narrative with the loss of their medical licenses.

**AB 1797** sets up a state immunization registry to monitor population compliance.

**SB 6** allows developers to build low to moderate income housing projects and emergency shelters in areas of your town currently zoned for office, retail, or parking use. This is one of many laws using the "less fortunate" as an excuse to decrease our quality of life. In similar fashion, "climate change" is used to litter the natural world with unreliable bird-killing metal windmills and Chinese slave-made solar panel desert gardens, as those in power gradually attempt to enclose us in electrical prisons.

#### **Other new laws:**

**SB 1087** is an attempt by our legislators to respond to a ten-fold increase in the theft of catalytic converters. Catalytic converters contain rhodium, palladium, and/or platinum, which can be recycled. This law increases recycler documentation requirements. Non-compliance is a misdemeanor.

**AB 351** increases the options in California starting January 1, 2027, for dealing with human remains. In addition to the traditional burial and cremation, hydrolysis using water and lye has been legal since 2020. In a few years composting will be added to the mix!

**CFRW recommends a NO vote on all propositions except for Proposition 31.** A YES vote on Proposition 31 bans the sale of flavored tobacco products. Interesting that the state appears intent on restricting nicotine use even though there are now safer delivery forms. Nicotine, while addictive, increases cognitive function. Contrast this with cannabis, which decreases cognitive function and damages the still developing brains of adolescents and young adults.

There are also medical exemptions (no age restrictions) and low-income deductions (no age restrictions) you may qualify through PG & E.
